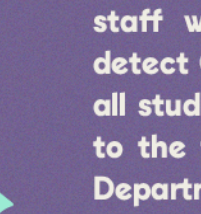

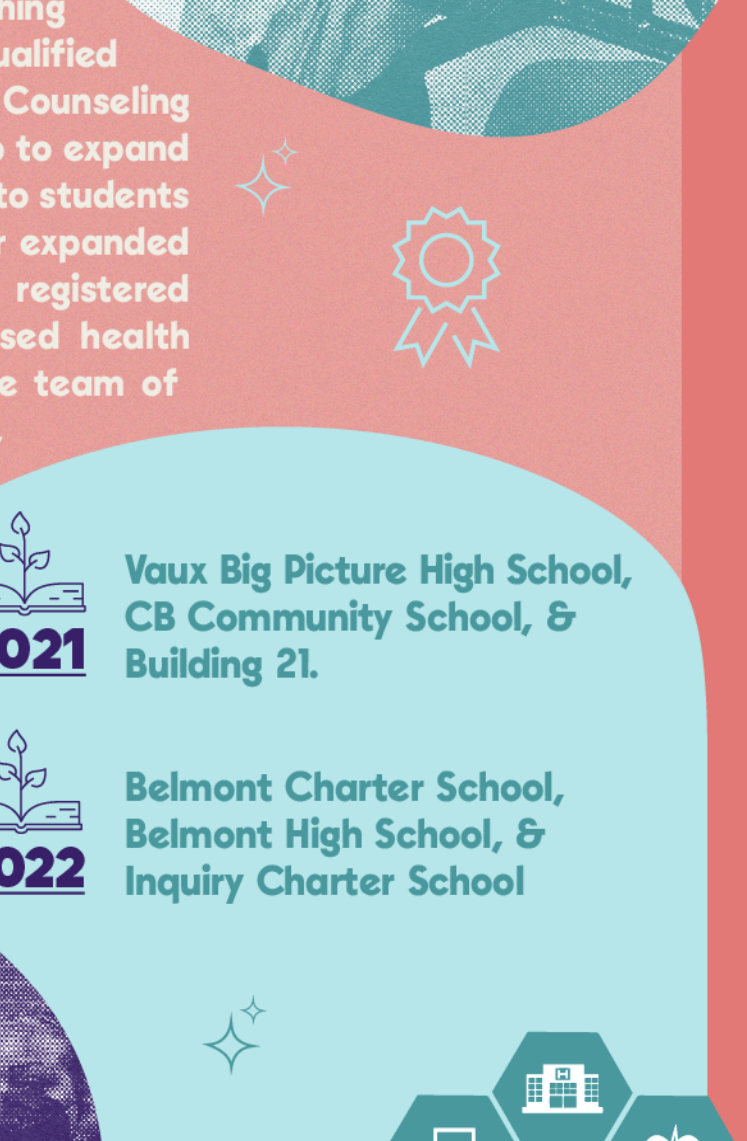


School During the COVID-19 Pandemic

Most schools remained virtual in 2021, opening to a hybrid model in late spring and then fully opening in the fall. Two schools remained open the entire year, CB Community School and La Salle Academy. As a result the organization was able to screen just 759 students to identify areas of concern for the SBHC team.

Education Plus Health hired a team to perform weekly assurance testing for COVID-19 for 6 school partners. Over 450 students and staff were tested weekly February through June to proactively detect COVID-19 in the schools and assure the health and safety of all students to learn at their full potential in the pandemic. Thanks to the team at CHOP's Project ACE-IT! and also the Philadelphia Department of Public Health for their support of this initiative.

Education Plus Health teamed up with Belmont Charter High School to host a COVID vaccine clinic for teens. St. Christopher's Hospital for Children's Dr. Roberta Laguerre spoke to the students and school community about the critical importance of the COVID vaccine. 30 students participated in the event.



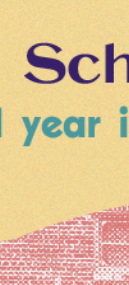
Education Plus Health embarked on an historic collaborative venture in 2021 launching the SBHC Collaborative with federally qualified health center provider Family Practice & Counseling Network (FPCN). The organizations team up to expand the scope and breadth of services offered to students under a federally-supported framework for expanded resources overall. The advanced-practice registered nurse practitioners leading the school-based health centers are supported by a comprehensive team of school nurses, behavioral health counselors, dentists, and community health workers. Six schools will relaunch as the SBHC Collaborative in 2021.

The Building 21 High School 21st Century after-school program spends its final year in the COVID pandemic, and beautifies the school yard.

The garden club built garden beds to grow vegetables and flowers for its neighborhood community and had a beautiful bounty. Education Plus Health launched the 21st Century program with Building 21 High School in 2015 serving more than 240 students each year with arts and academic clubs for student growth and development.



Education Plus Health's community health workers led health clubs virtually at the Building 21 and People for People Charter School 21st Century programs, including the Seeds of Wellness club where they learned to make hygiene products to nurture the soul.

Education Plus Health's Room 2 Breathe program served 191 asthmatic children in 2021 with virtual and home-based education and trigger reduction services to improve asthma outcomes. The program operates under the support of the Philadelphia Department of Public Health and in collaboration to serve pediatric patients at St. Christopher's Hospital for Children and Temple Pediatrics.

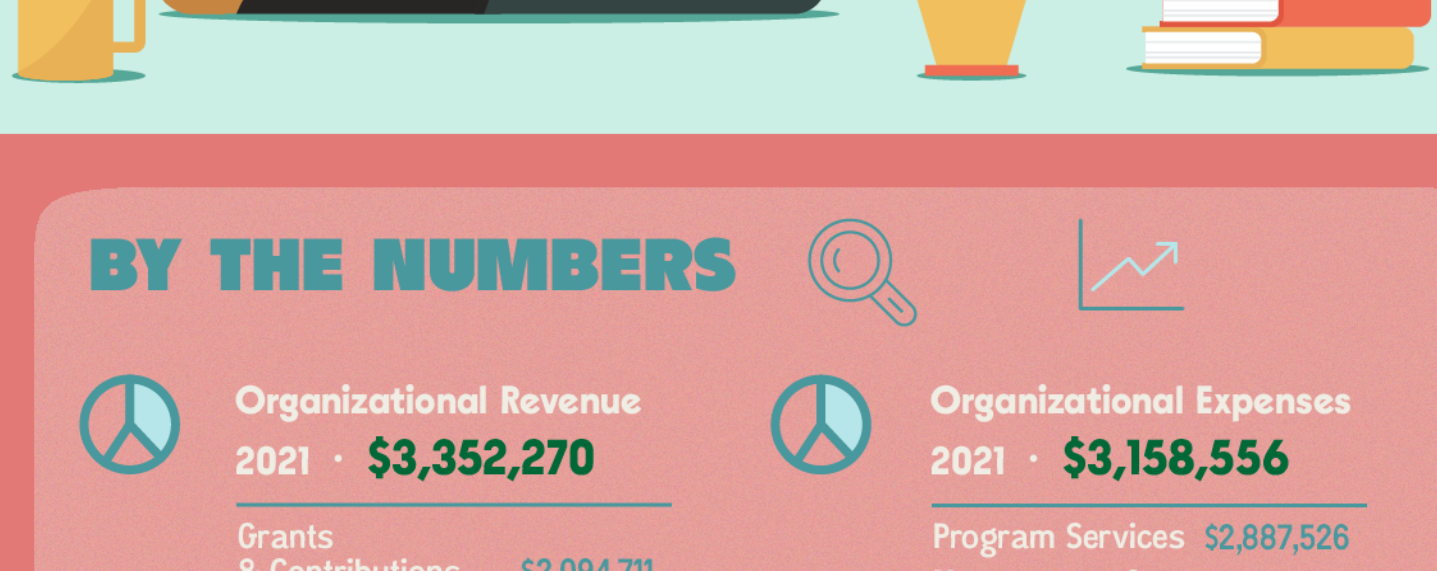


Education Plus Health continued to team up with Diversified Community Services and I-Lead to bring the Harcum College Associate's Degree Program to South Philadelphia.

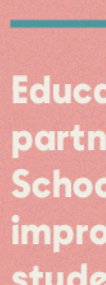
The cohort continued virtually through 2021.

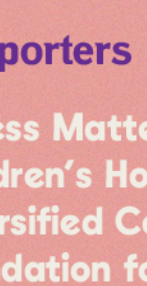

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OUR TEAM

NURSE PRACTITIONER (NP)

With a wide scope of practice, NPs are equipped to evaluate & diagnose patients, order & interpret diagnostic tests, initiate & manage treatments & medications.

LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE (LPN)

LPNs are the glue that holds the nurse's office together. LPNs ensure students' acute & urgent needs are met and work closely with NPs to manage student care.

COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKER (CHW)

The bridge between healthcare and the community, CHWs work with students and families to manage care with education, getting insurance and more.

HEALTH RESOURCE COORDINATOR (HRC)

HRCs work with school leadership to implement sexual health education curriculum and evolve supportive school policies. They counsel youth to make safe and healthy decisions.

AFTER SCHOOL COORDINATOR

After School coordinators plan and implement programs and activities that enrich students' lives both socially and academically.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH COUNSELOR (BHC)

When students present mental health symptoms or distress, our Master's level clinicians intervene to connect youth to care and build coping skills through individual and group sessions.



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
